



Visiting our centre in Accrington

The Accrington Assessment Centre is found in the Globe Centre in St James's Square, Accrington, BB5 0RE.

By Car

From Burnley

Follow the A666 then A678 onto Accrington Road, Blackburn Road, turn right onto Willows Lane, Brown Street, slight left on to Ormerod Street.

From Rochdale

Use M66 towards Burnley, Blackburn – use A56 on Haslingden bypass at Rising Bridge Roundabout, take the 1st exit onto Blackburn Rd/A680, at the roundabout, take the 1st exit and stay on Blackburn Rd/A680, continue to follow A680, turn left onto Spring Gardens, Continue onto Wellington St, continue onto Church St, at the roundabout, take the 1st exit onto Paradise St, then at the roundabout, take the 1st exit onto Eagle St, at the roundabout, take the 2nd exit onto Scaitcliffe St, destination will be on the left. Arrival.

When you arrive, drive in via the car park entrance and not the road entrance, to avoid the step stairs leading into the building. You will need to give your vehicle registration at reception, so they are able to register your car.
