

Visiting our centre in Manchester

The Manchester Assessment Centre is found in the A J Bell Stadium 1 Stadium Way, Barton- Upon - Irwell, Salford, M30 7EY.

By Car

The stadium is situated at Barton, off the M60, Junction 11. Postcode for sat navs: M30 7LJ

By Bus

Buses from Manchester City Centre and Eccles: Number 67 to Liverpool Road, Irlam.

Buses from the Trafford Centre: Number 100 to Liverpool Road, Irlam. This is a 15-minute walk from the Liverpool Road stop. Many services connect here from across the region.

By Taxi

By Train

The nearest train stations are Irlam and Patricroft. For both stations walk towards Liverpool Road and take the number 67 bus (as above).

By Tram

The nearest Metrolink tram stop is Eccles. From here, the stadium is approximately 40-minute walk or take the number 67 bus along Liverpool Road as above.

When you arrive for your assessment in Manchester, you will find a waiting/reception area and easily accessible toilets. If you need anything, Aldi is a 2-minute walk away and the Farmhouse pub is across the road. If you are dropping someone of and fancy a short drive to find some refreshment, the Trafford Centre is a 5-minute drive away and The Chill Factor is 2 minutes' drive away with coffee shops, Nando's, and Weatherspoon's.

Assessments Service in Manchester

Our assessment service in Manchester operates Monday to Friday.

There are a variety of assessments available at our Manchester centre. You can take car driving assessments, Motorcycle Assessments, Group 2 vehicle assessments (LGV & PSV) and can also receive driving tuition. If you are elderly, you might be interested in our Older Driver Improvement services. Electric wheelchair & scooter driving assessments are also available along with wheelchair/scooter loading assessments (including WAV).

If you have trouble accessing your car, we offer driver and passenger seating/access assessments. There are also high-tech driving adaptation assessments, such as Drive From Wheelchair. If you have young children, you may be interested in our Paediatric assessments for car seating (including restraints) and powered wheelchairs. The centre also offers accessible travel advice and information along with postural support seating solutions for air travel.
