

Visiting our centre in Shrewsbury

The Shrewsbury Assessment Centre is found at The Lantern, Meadow Farm Drive, Shrewsbury, SY1 4NG.

By Car

From the North Whitchurch A49 / Market Drayton AA53

Follow the A49/A453 towards Shrewsbury following signs towards the A5 Telford.

At the junction with the B5062 turn right into Sundorne Road.

Go over the 2nd mini roundabout passed the sports centre on the left, at the 3rd mini roundabout turn right (3rd exit) on to Meadow Farm Drive. At the next roundabout go straight ahead (2nd exit) and then take the next turning on the right.

From the A5

Follow the A49 at the junction with the A5 towards Whitchurch.

At the1st roundabout turn left onto Sundorne Road.

Go over the 2nd mini roundabout passed the sports centre on the left, at the 3rd mini roundabout turn right (3rd exit) on to Meadow Farm Drive. At the next roundabout go straight ahead (2nd exit) and then take the next turning on the right.

From the City Centre A5191 or the A5112.

Turn right at the roundabout on to B5062 Sundorne Road.

At the roundabout turn left (1st exit), then at the next roundabout follow the road ahead. Take the next turning on the right.

Assessments Service in Shrewsbury

Our assessment service in Shrewsbury operates on a Tuesday & Wednesday

Not only can you take driving assessments at our Shrewsbury centre, but you can also have driver/
passenger access/seating assessments. Wheelchair/scooter loading assessments (including WAV) are
also available.

At the centre, you will find plenty of parking onsite and accessible toilets. There is a waiting area available along with a library and café. You will need to ask for RDAC at the reception desk. If you need anything else, you can also find Tesco 5 minutes' drive away from the centre.
